Please be advised that the Association of Nova Scotia Land Surveyors will be holding its 69th AGM on **October 17-19, 2019** at the [Holliday Inn](#) Hotel & Convention Centre, Truro, Nova Scotia. 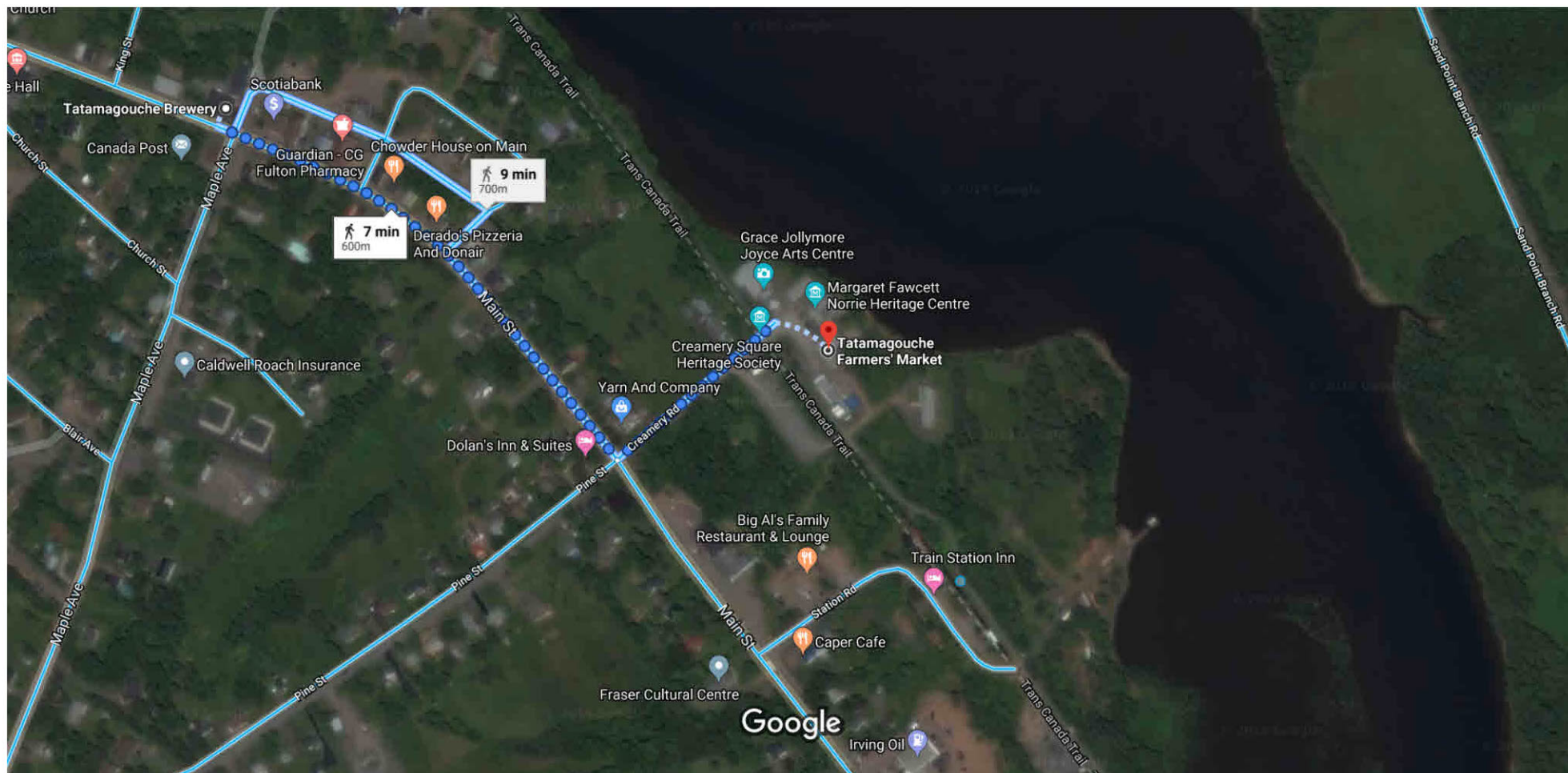
